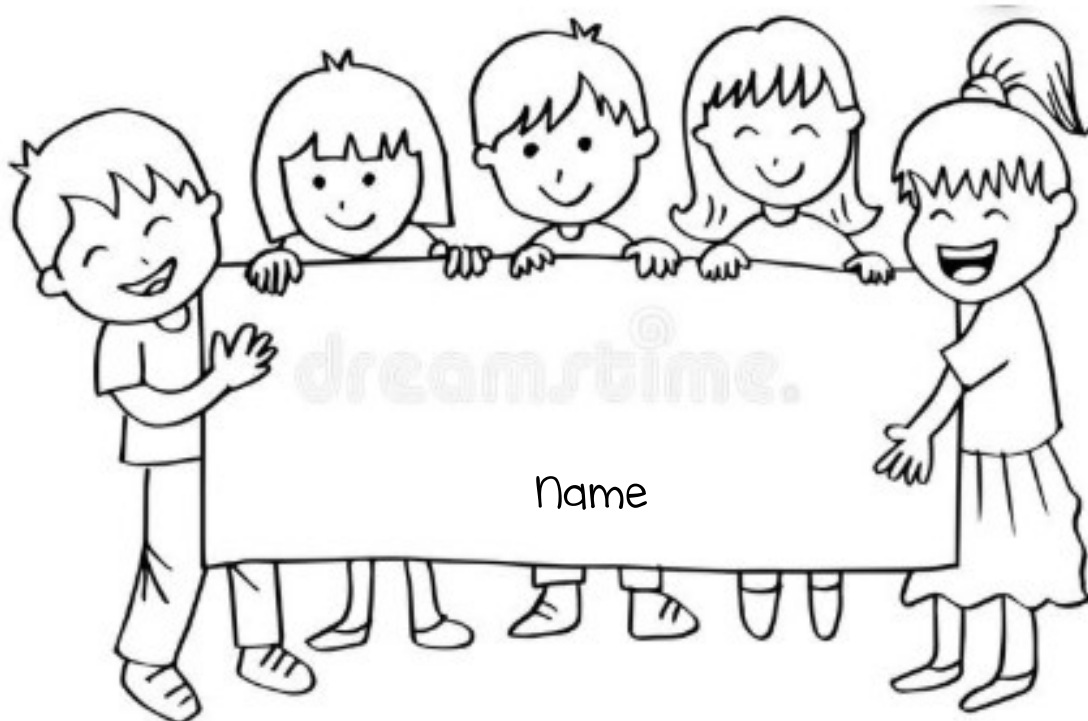

Week 8 Night and day animals.

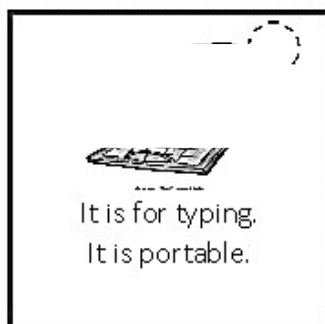
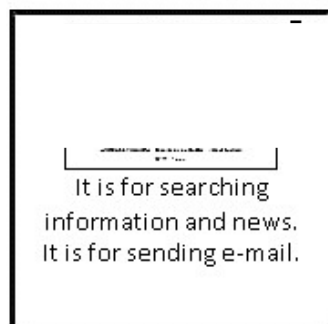
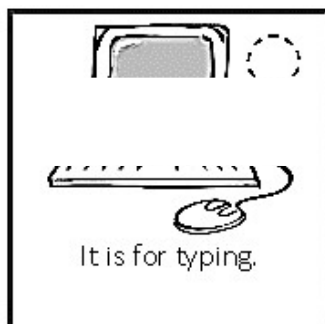

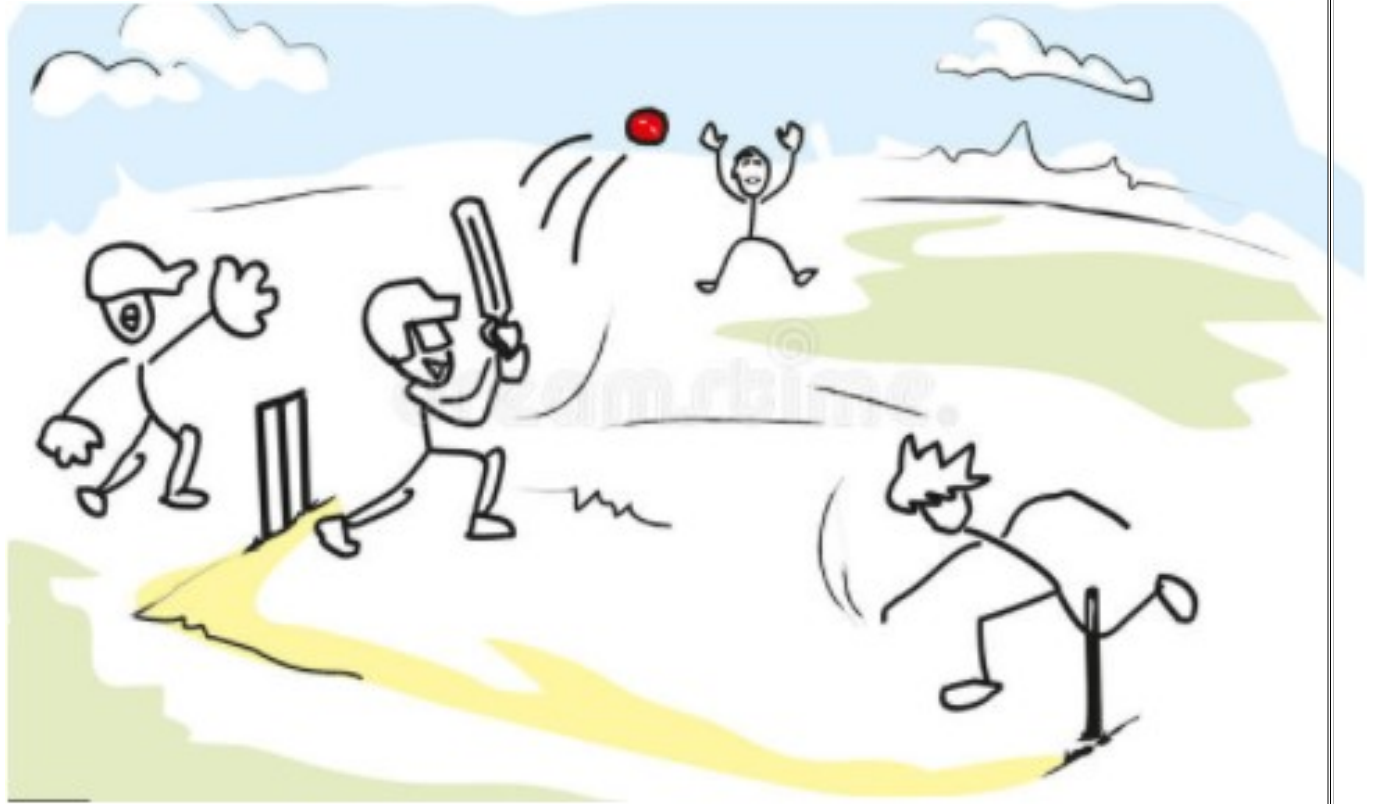
Number the picture from 1 to 12 and then write a sentence about 4 of the pictures of your choice.
