Your report should have the following structure: Introduction, body, and conclusion.

Your research must be **4-5 pages**. Use a **variety of resources**. You will have to do extra research – visit the local library for books and magazines, newspapers, magazines, search the internet, interview peers and adults who have experienced substance abuse or are living with it.



## The following must be included in your project/research

- 1. Cover page (with your name, grade and topic.)
- 2. Content/Index.
- 3. **Introduction** (It should state what will be investigated and discussed in the report.)
- 4. Body.
  - 4.1. Definition of Substance abuse.
  - 4.2. Type of substance abuse (for example, is it legal or illegal substance).
  - 4.3. Physical and emotional effects of the abuse on the abuser.
  - 4.4. Effect of this abuse on the family or community of the abuser.
  - 4.5. Persons who typically abuses this substance (young people? old people? rich people?, poor people and so on)
  - 4.6. Information about how widespread the abuse is and in what parts of South Africa it is a problem.
  - 4.7. Persons who typically abuses this substance (young people? old people? rich people? poor people and so on).
  - 4.8. Rehabilitation fabilities available to help addicts and how the substance abuse is treated.
  - 4.9. Long term effects of this type of substance abuse.
- 5. **Conclusion**. (It should summaries what is discussed in the body).
- 6. Bibliography/Resources.
